ORANGEVALE PARK/ COMMUNITY CENTER DISTRICT **ESTABLISHMENT**

Almost forty years ago the Orangevale Recreation and Park District was created. We had seven parks in the town, but they were managed by the Sunrise Recreation and Park District. People in the community felt we were not getting the fair share of county services for the taxes paid.

Their efforts paid off when the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors voted to establish an independent park district in Orangevale in August of 1983.

The new Orangevale Park District received seven park sites from the Sunrise Park District, the Orangevale Community Park; Orangevale Youth Center Park; Snipes/Pershing Park (now Norma Hamlin Park): Palisades Park; Pecan Park; Rollingwood Nature Area and Sundance Park with Almond Park from the Fair Oaks Park District. The Board agreed the park sites were pretty much ignored and underdeveloped.

In the summer of 1988, Orangevale Community Center, Inc. formed by Charlie Clark, who was also a director of the Orangevale Recreation and Park Dis-

trict, to begin the drive for the building of a Community Center in Orangevale. The group held fundraisers to acquire funds to get the center built. The Directors had selected six tentative sites. In April 1989, the Board of Directors chose the site across the street from their park offices at the Youth center. It was two parcels owned by Anselmo/ McNabb.

Director Lianna Errecart had been in negotiations with Jill Anselmo for this property when she found out that the Mormon Church had purchased it for the price of \$780,000 around May of 1990, but only included eleven acres for the church. The Sacramento County Board of Supervisors granted the district's request to approve eminent domain proceedings for the community center site at 6800 Hazel Avenue.

One of everyone's favorite desserts is Pineapple Upside-Down Cake. National Upside-down Pineapple Cake Day was April 20th this year. This week I am sharing a recipe that I finally got my hands on in 2015. I work with Vallerie Whitehorn at Ottomon Elementary and she used to bring this delicious cake to the events at our own children's elementary school (Coleman). When I started working with her at Ottomon, she generously shared the recipe with me. She knew it by heart because she has been making this cake for years. Originally, I made the cake by using just the ingredients in my kitchen, so my first cake was made with pineapple chunks and no cherries and it came out just fine!

VALLERIE'S PINEAPPLE UPSIDE-DOWN CAKE

Yellow Cake Mix Eggs – (amount called for on cake mix box)

Vegetable oil- (amount called for on cake mix box)

1 can (20oz)- Canned Pineapple rings, drained, juice reserved

1 cup brown sugar, packed 34 stick of butter (6 tablespoons)

Maraschino cherries without

stems, cut in half

Heat oven to 350 degrees Prepare cake batter by following directions on the box except use the reserved juice instead of the

water. You may need to add water to this to reach the amount needed; set batter aside.

Place butter in an empty pan. Put pan in oven to melt butter.

This should take a few minutes. Vallerie uses a cast iron skillet approximately 11 inches diameter.

You can use a large cake pan or even a 13x9 pan.

When butter is melted, take pan out of oven. Evenly distribute brown sugar in pan. Place pineapple rings

on top of brown sugar in a nice arrangement, you may need to cut some rings to fit the pan.

Put cherries in the center of the rings, round side down. Gently pour cake batter over the pineapple. Spread even-

Bake for the amount of time specified on the box or until a toothpick comes out clean. Remove from oven and wait 10 minutes, then run a knife around the edges of the pan and then place cake plate securely over top of cake (Be sure cake plate is larger than the pan!)

Very carefully flip the cake over and carefully lift pan
