**DENNIS BURMASTER 1951-2023**

Dennis Delbert Burmaster, of Orangevale, CA, after several years of ill health, passed away peacefully in his home on December 6, 2023, surrounded by loved ones. Dennis was 72 years old. He was born on May 22, 1951, to Felecia (McKinney) and Delbert Burmaster. He attended schools in the Orangevale area and, with the exception of a few years in Montana, lived in Orangevale his entire life. Dennis has two sons, Matthew and Gary.

As a Master Craftsman for over 40 years, Dennis held licenses in General Building and Plumbing. He poured his heart and soul into his All City Plumbing business until retiring due to failing health. Even while retired, concern for his customers never wavered.

In addition to owning and operating All City Plumbing, Dennis was a member of the Jeepers Jamboree Mechanics Club. The Jamboree is an annual three day, guided off-road excursion over the Sierra Nevada Mountain Range's famous Rubicon Trail. In his capacity as an off-road vehicle specialist, Dennis was responsible for ensuring Jamboree attendees and/or their vehicles were not left stranded on the trail. Over the years, he would take either one of his sons or friends with him on the trail to assist in helping others. Dennis was also a member of the Hastings Island Pheasant Club in Rio Vista, CA. When Den-

nis did have free time, he enjoyed off-roading, hunting, fishing, blacksmithing, skeet shooting, and listening to music with his family and/or his many friends.

Dennis was able to work on an extensive bucket list over the years. Two of his more memorable excursions were his solo participation in an African Safari and rainbow trout fishing in Alaska with his son Matt.

During the past several years, chronic illness left Dennis restricted in his mobility. Even that didn't deter him from doing things he enjoyed. His friends constructed an elaborate ramp so he was able to move about outside of his home. As much as he was able, he enjoyed working in his garage, and he became a tree/bush planting beast (with assistance from his gardener) up until shortly before his passing.

Everyone who knew Dennis knew how he was; full of light, joy, and positivity, traits that were obvious to all even after a single meeting with him. Dennis is survived by his two sons, Matthew Burmaster and Gary Burmaster; two grandchildren, Megan Parmeter and Abby Burmaster; and many friends. He will be missed more than words can say.

**NAIDA A. EFFINGER  
1925-2023**

It is with great sorrow that we announce that longtime Orangevale resident Naida A. (Stevenson) Effinger, age 98, died peacefully on Christmas Day 2023 at her home on Walnut Ave with family by her side. She was born November 19, 1925 in Higbee, Missouri, the only child of James Weaver & Lottie A. Stevenson who owned a dairy farm. Due to health issues from his service in WW1, her father needed to move to a warmer climate. In 1936 they sold the farm and moved to Orangevale, where they built a home on the corner of Walnut and Orangevale Ave around 1940.

Naida graduated from Orangevale Grammar School in 1939, where she was instructed by Sadie Cable. She graduated from San Juan High School in 1942 and earned a Business Degree at Sacramento City College. She was employed as an Executive Secretary for the State Veterans Board and in later years the Children's Receiving Home in Sacramento until her retirement in 1985.

However, Naida's first job was packing fruit at Sol Warhaftig's packing shed, where she wrote her name and address on a divider of plums to see if she could get a pen pal. That box of plums ended up in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania where 16 year old Andrew F. Effinger resided and worked as a "husker"

driving a fruit truck. He responded to her note starting a seven year courtship that lasted throughout WW2.

On April 3rd 1948 Andrew & Naida were married at the historic St. John's Catholic Church in Folsom. They built their home next door to Naida's parents where they have lived for 75 years, raising three sons, Lawrence and Paul, (deceased) and Michael. In April 2023 they celebrated their 75th Wedding Anniversary.

Naida was active in the Scouting Program, a member of the Orangevale Woman's Club and a longtime parishioner of St John's and Divine Savior Catholic Church. Her

love for Orangevale started as a child and lasted her entire life. She stated many times that there was no better place to live. Her incredible love, kind nature and gentle smile will be deeply missed. Naida is survived by her husband Andrew, son Michael, daughter-in-law Kathryn and step-grandson Cole Mayjoffo.

A Mass will be held at 1 PM Monday January 22, 2024 at Divine Savior Catholic Church, 9079 Greenback Lane, Orangevale followed by interment at the Sylvan Cemetery in Citrus Heights, CA. Relatives, friends and family are welcome to attend

# ORANGEVALE COOKS

In this issue, I am sharing a recipe for chicken pot pie. My sister gave me this recipe a few years ago and I shared it with you, but I had forgotten about it! It is an easy meal for a delicious pot pie from puff pastry shells. Even though there are many variations of pot pie, this is a perfect comfort food for the month of January.

### CHICKEN POT PIE

(Based on the recipe from Pepperidge Farm)  
1 pkg (10 oz.) frozen Pepperidge Farm Puff Pastry

Shells  
1 Tbsp. vegetable oil  
1 medium onion, chopped finely  
1 can condensed cream of chicken soup (any variety)  
½ cup milk  
1 pkg (10 oz.) frozen peas and carrots or your favorite frozen vegetables  
2 cups cooked chicken, cut in bite-sized pieces

Bake, cool and remove tops of pastry shells according to the directions on the package of puff pastry shells. Heat oil in large skillet over medium heat. Add onion and cook until tender. Add soup, milk and frozen vegetables to the skillet and heat to a boil. Reduce heat to low and cover with a lid. Cook for 5 minutes or until vegetables are tender and heated through. Add chicken and cook until mixture is hot

and bubbly. Serve in pastry shells.

According to the package directions, this was supposed to serve 6, but if you are someone with a regular appetite, this will serve 3 adults. The mixture should be overflowing the shells.

My sister uses the grocery store rotisserie chicken for her chicken, but I used the 13 oz. canned chicken breast that I get at Costco and Sam's Club. I also used 16 oz. of frozen vegetables to make up for the smaller amount of chicken.

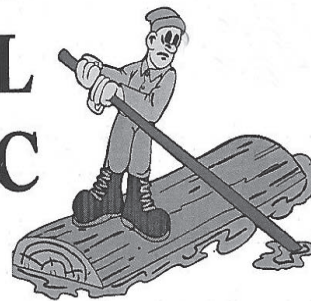

## CASA ROBLE VARSITY BOYS BASKETBALL KICKS OFF THE SEASON WITH A WIN

Following the success of last season with a 12-0 record, the highly-anticipated 2024 season for the Casa Roble Varsity Boys Basketball team is off and running! Up to this point, the team has held a solid record throughout preseason.

"I'm pleased with the way the season is going," said Head Coach Nate Gilbert. "We are off to a great start with a record of 11-5. We put in a lot of hard work over the last three years building the program and it's really paying off."

Next up, the team is set to play against Pioneer on January 5th. Pioneer is currently ranked 4th in the league, recently starting the season with a narrow loss against Dixon. After that, Casa will take on Mesa Verde in a home game on January 8th, who currently stand at 3rd in league.

"We started off league with a win, and plan to finish again as league champs!" said Coach Gilbert. "Go Rams".
